This is our first vibrating church which recently is planted in one of the slum areas where we've been active in. 80 people of average attending over the last 6 Sunday services. We've seen God's been moving in such the very powerful ways to heal everyone both men,

women and children. The last service we had about 200 children and adults are coming to our Light of Christ Fellowship, and 100 out of them are accepting Christ as their personal savior in their lives. The harvest is ripe enough to be harvested, but the harvesters are few! We prayed that God will send our ways of the harvesters. We continued training our next generation of leaders of this community to take on the responsibility when the right time comes. We are focusing on 5 purposes of a healthy church.

Discipleship Training Program
