#1 School Building

It's so incredible to see these children are hungry for their education. When we started building this school building, they are mobilizing their friends to come to support us at Cambodian Care. Each day, they all are working so hard, their hands are too busy from little to the teenage boys and girls. While they were working, they kept asking us when are we having this school start? This same question is repeatedly asked all the times during our

ground work. Their hunger for education is so high and motivated them to move faster according to our plans. We saw young adults and adults started showing up to take ownership of this project. Finally and successfully, this one of the school buildings was done. There are two hundred kids have signed up with us at Light of Future School at Cambodian Care. We expect this school to be opening on November, 2014.

We are also building our second school at the train track area. The vast majority of these children are suffering from quality education. We are leasing a property there, so that we are able to build and put up school over there. We're able to take 350 students for that school. These children are also hungry for their school. They always asked us about when is the school built? All we could say to them is "one step at time"! The community people are coming to join us to lay concrete as part of their labor to contribute to this school. We expect this school is ready by December, 2014. We're now in the process of buying more chair, tables, whiteboards, etc.

Why always leadership development program? Teenagers are the great sources of great future leaders for the great future of Cambodia. At Cambodian Care, we saw this is one of the great opportunities to train up young leaders from where they are to where they are called to lead. Recently, we sent a team of our students from Light of Future School to serve at the Global Leadership Summit in Phnom Penh hosted by ICA church and funded by Willow Creek Community Church (Pastor Bill Hybels). It was a great opportunity for these young teenagers to be able to serve and watch from their role model people. Building up their self-confident and shaping their character to grow from challenge to challenge.



Teen Leadership Development Program is one of the 6 major programs of Cambodian Care. In the next following month, we are launching it and we are expecting 30 young leaders to be on a 2 year commitment programs. The goal of this program is to prepare them and allowing them the opportunity to serve within the school and their community from where they are.
