

Teen Leadership Development Program

Teen Leadership Development/Discipleship Program is of the 6 core programs of Cambodian Care. We believe that every teenager has the great potential to change Cambodia positively when they are reaching their potential. The whole idea of this program is to help them grow in character, moral and skills to live and to lead from where they are to where they are called. We are launching this program on the following first week of this December, 2014. We're only taking 30 students to be in this one-year program. Until now 20 students from the communities where Cambodian Care 's been active in already have signed up with us.
