It consists of 200 families who have been settling for several years. Most of adults having jobs with garment factory. 80% of children population who are living in that slum are not attending government school. It takes about 50 minutes riding a

There are 500 families who have been settling alongside the train track area. The vast majority of those children are not attending Government school. According to our Community Education School team's registration worksheet has shown that 60% of those children who are living alongside the train track area have never been to school.

Cambodian Care has seen such a great need of quality education for those children who are struggling with. There are too many reasons that come behind it. We're in still process of running legal papers to use those trains.


Child Support Program
